 - Total expenses during the month were \$254

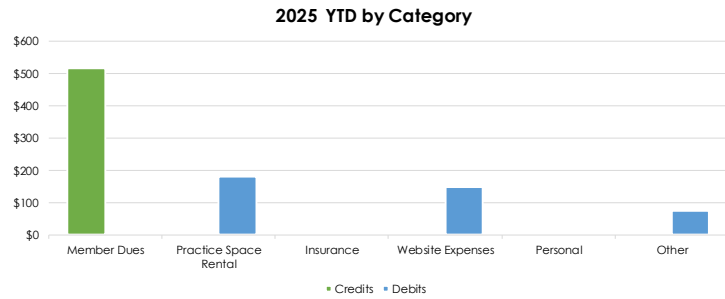
- 2 months of practice space rental hit this month + the purchase of the con kit container)

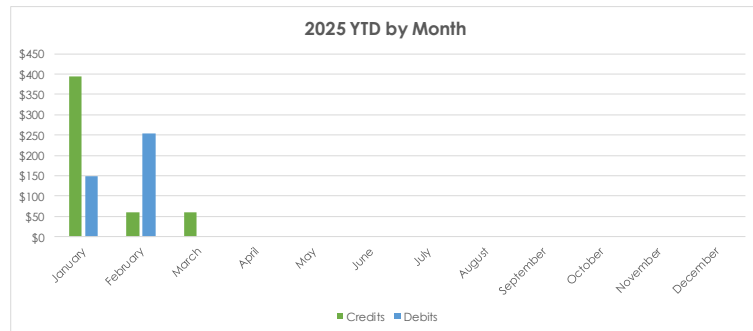

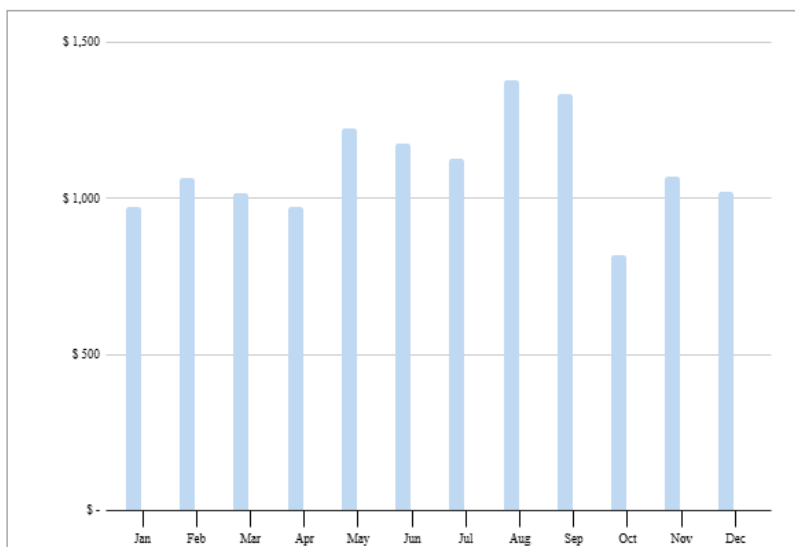


- Budget for 2025 has been prepared. Here is the cash flow summary. I have the detailed budget available for anyone who is interested.

FIGHT DIRECTOR

- In the beginning of February we did a costume/fight reapproval. That night we got 7 fights reapproved. So in one night I approved with the help of Eric 7 fights which is more fights than I approved last year. I have a folder with the fight approval sheet in it and it has all fights that have been approved.
- I am looking to add some new stretches in our routine.
- I updated the practice lesson sheet until the end of March.
- Next week we start the way we do Critique a fight again. We will do this in a manner where I will give you time to work on fights then we will meet and show off and critique then finish our open choreography with show a fight ending the night. This is a reminder to please keep comments serious to the fights and please be open to the suggestions they are only to help our fights look cleaner and get better overall.
- I have adjusted my lesson time so that we have time for show prep which is going well.
- I also had a conversation with Dan about all fights being approved in costume. If the costume has already been approved the fight just needs to be approved by me at any practice. The only exception to this rule will be if the costume has any major safety concerns like Vader with the limited vision things like that then every fight will have to be approved in costume.
- I am hoping to work with either Dan or Nick on correcting my write ups of Shi Sho, and Absqito.
- **Li is coming on March 29, 2025 to teach a lesson again.**
- I love seeing all the hard work the club is putting into our fights.
- If anyone has anything they want me to include in lesson plans please reach out to me and I will do my best to make it happen. Keep up the good work guys.

 - Targeting to keep the costs around or under \$150 initially
